# **Adult Immunisation Routine Schedule**

#### 

Vaccination	Eligibility
Seasonal Influenza	65+ years (turn 65 by 31/3/26) 18-64 years in clinical risk groups Pregnant women
Pneumococcal	65+ years 2-64 years in clinical risk groups
Shingles	65 years 70-79 (catch up) 18 + years if severely immunosuppressed
RSV	75-79 years Pregnant women (from 28 weeks)
COVID-19	75+ years (turn 75 by 31/1/26) Older care home patients 6 months + years who are immunocompromised
