



What are reasonable adjustments?

Small changes put in place by health and care staff to help you get the right care.

You may need help if you have:

- A disability (body, senses or learning)
- Autism
- A long-term Condition (like dementia)

Examples of reasonable adjustments are...

- Bring someone with you
- Quiet space or quiet time
- Bring an assistance dog
- Easy access (no steps)
- Visit before your appointment
